BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 15, aggregated \$12,159,143,000, or 28.9 per cent above the total of \$9,431,208,000 reported for the preceeding week which comprised only five business days.

Total debits for the week under review are \$1,340,000 or .01 per cent below those for the week ending September 16, 1925. New York City reports an increase of \$58,000,000 as compared with last year, Chicago of \$45,000,000, and Philadelphia \$35,000,000, while debits at San Francisco declined \$28,000,000 and at Los Angeles \$19,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$11,420,000,000 as compared with \$11,813,595,000 for the preceding week and \$11,430,014,000 for the week ending September 16, 1925.
