BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 13, aggregated \$11,269,000,000 or 20.7 per cent below the total of \$14,202,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$586,000,000 or 5.5 per cent above those for the week ending October 14, 1925. New York City reports an increase of \$578,000,000, Cleveland \$39,000,000 and Boston \$37,000,000, while Chicago and Minneapolis reported reductions of \$40,000,000 and \$15,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$10,563,623,000 as compared with \$13,347,539,000 for the preceding week and \$10,001,553,000 for the week ending October 14, 1925.
