## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 24, 1926, aggregated \$12,014,000,000 or 3.9 per cent below the total of \$12,497,000,000 reported for the previous week, which included but five business days at most of the reporting centers.

Total debits for the week under review are \$250,000,000 or 2 per cent below those for the week ending November 25, 1925. New York City reported a decline of \$22,000,000, Detroit \$38,000,000, Baltimore and Minneapolis \$13,000,000 each, New Orleans \$12,000,000 and Pittsburgh \$11,000,000. The largest increases were: Cleveland \$20,000,000, Los Angeles \$18,000,000, Chicago \$13,000,000 and Boston \$12,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,273,253,000 as compared with \$11,726,212,000 for the preceding week and \$11,557,605,000 for the week ending November 25, 1925.
