BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 1, 1926, aggregated \$11,460,000,000 or 4.7 per cent below the total of \$12,020,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The current week included Thanksgiving Day, which was observed as a holiday throughout the country.

Total debits for the week under review are \$240,000,000 or 2 per cent below those for the week ending December 2, 1925, which also included but five business days. Pittsburgh reported a decline of \$41,000,000, New York City and St. Louis \$30,000,000 each, Detroit \$28,000,000, and Boston and New Orleans \$20,000,000 each. The largest increase, \$86,000,000, was reported by Chicago.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$10,758,166,000 as compared with \$11,273,263,000 for the preceding week and \$10,980,790,000 for the week ending December 2, 1925.
