## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 22, 1926, aggregated \$14,148,000,000 or 3.3 per cent above the total of \$13,700,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$969,000,000 or 7.4 per cent above those for the week ending December 23, 1925. New York City reported an increase of \$714,000,000, Chicago \$76,000,000, Boston \$63,000,000, Cleveland \$22,000,000 and Los Angeles \$21,000,000. A decline of \$25,000,000 was reported by Detroit.

Aggregate debits for 141 <sup>about</sup> centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$13,335,000,000 compared with \$12,911,292,000 for the preceding week and \$12,353,699,000 for the week ending December 23, 1925.

Owing to the fact that New Year's falls on Saturday, the Board's statement for the week ending December 29 will be issued Monday, January 3, 1927.
