BANK DEBITS

debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by
leading cities for the week ending April 13, 1927, aggregated
\$15,022,000 or 12.8 per cent below the total of \$15,622,000,000 reported for
preceding week.

total debits for the week under review were \$1,207,000,000 or 10.1 per cent
above for the week ending April 14, 1926. New York City reported an in-
crease of \$1,041,000,000, Pittsburgh \$142,000,000 and Boston \$31,000,000. The
decrease, \$72,000,000, was reported by Philadelphia

aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published
since January 1919 amounted to \$12,319,141,000, as compared with
\$13,000,000 for the preceding week and \$11,139,775,000 for the week ending
April 14, 1926.
