BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by
 in leading cities for the week ending June 8, 1927, aggregated
 \$15,000,000 or 12.5 per cent above the total of \$12,791,000,000 reported for
 preceding week, which included but five business days for most of the reporting

Total debits for the week under review are \$2,619,000,000, or 22.2 per cent
 above those for the week ending June 9, 1926. New York City reported an increase
 of \$15,000,000, Chicago \$163,000,000, Boston \$104,000,000, San Francisco
 \$100,000, Philadelphia \$47,000,000, Cleveland \$36,000,000, and Cincinnati and
 Memphis \$20,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly
 in January 1919 amounted to \$13,500,305,000, as compared with \$12,099,294,000
 for the preceding week and \$11,028,042,000 for the week ending June 9, 1926.
