BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by
 in leading cities for the week ending June 15, 1927, aggregated
 \$14,000,000 or 5.9 per cent below the total of \$14,399,000,000 reported for
 preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$875,000,000 or 6.9 per cent
 those for the week ending June 16, 1926. New York City reported an in-
 of \$753,000,000, Pittsburgh \$95,000,000, Boston \$43,000,000, San Francisco
 \$20,000,000, and Cleveland \$26,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly
 January 1919 amounted to \$12,787,599,000, as compared with \$13,603,675,000
 preceding week and \$11,892,099,000 for the week ending June 16, 1926.
