BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 20, 1927, aggregated \$13,024,000,000 or about 1 per cent below the total of \$13,154,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$759,000,000 or 6.2 percent above those for the week ending July 21, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$722,000,000, Chicago \$35,000,000 and San Francisco \$1,400,000, while decreases of \$18,000,000 and \$14,000,000 were reported by Detroit and Baltimore, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$12,245,000,000, as compared with \$12,331,745,000 for the preceding week and \$11,476,259,000 for the week ending July 21, 1926.
