BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 27, 1927, aggregated \$12,251,720,000 or 5 per cent below the total of \$13,035,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$1,291,000,000 or 11.3 per cent above those for the week ending July 28, 1925. New York City reported an increase of \$1,204,000,000, Boston \$27,000,000, Philadelphia \$23,000,000 and Cleveland \$2,000,000, while declines of \$20,000,000, \$19,000,000 and \$18,000,000 were reported by Denver, Pittsburgh and San Francisco, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published since January 1919 amounted to \$11,566,188,000, as compared with \$10,329,000 for the preceding week and \$10,285,953,000 for the week ending July 28, 1926.
