## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by  
 in leading cities for the week ending August 31, 1927, aggregated  
 \$12,087,906,000 or 2.2 per cent above the total of \$11,828,829,000 reported for  
 preceding week.

Total debits under review are \$1,024,474,000 or 9.3 per cent above those  
 for the week ending September 1, 1926. New York City reported an increase of  
 \$1,000,000, San Francisco \$32,000,000, and Boston, New Orleans and Los Angeles  
 \$200,000 each. Philadelphia reports a decline of \$12,000,000 and Buffalo a  
 decline of \$11,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published  
 since January 1919 amounted to \$11,451,053,000 as compared with  
 \$10,633,000 for the preceding week and \$10,424,599,000 for the week ending  
 September 1, 1926.
