BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board in leading cities for the week ending September 7, 1927, aggregated \$9,435,659,000 or 4.9 per cent below the total of \$12,087,285,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$2,062,783,000 or 21.9 per cent above those for the week ending September 8, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$1,501,000,000, Chicago \$155,000,000, Boston \$51,000,000, San Francisco \$50,000,000 and Philadelphia and Cleveland \$32,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published since January 1919 amounted to \$10,846,067,000 as compared with \$11,048,000 for the preceding week and \$8,818,785,000 for the week ending September 8, 1926.
