BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 28, 1927, aggregated \$13,679,000,000 or 10.7 per cent below the total of \$15,313,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$2,247,000,000 or 19.7 per cent above those for the week ending September 29, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$1,973,000,000, Chicago \$112,000,000, San Francisco \$93,000,000, Minneapolis \$35,000,000 and Cincinnati \$17,000,000, while Pittsburgh and Seattle reported reductions of \$21,000,000 and \$14,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published week since January 1919 amounted to \$12,994,428,000 as compared with \$14,523,003,000 for the preceding week and \$10,765,355,000 for the week ending September 29, 19
