BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 2, 1927, aggregated \$14,031,260,000 or 10.0 per cent above the total of \$14,031,670,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$3,922,000,000 or 34.1 per cent above those for the week ending November 3, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$2,798,000,000, Chicago \$207,000,000, San Francisco \$157,000,000, Boston \$100,000,000 and Philadelphia \$71,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published since January 1919 amounted to about \$14,654,000,000 as compared with \$13,291,244,000 for the preceding week and \$10,794,210,000 for the week ending November 3, 1926.
