BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 16, 1927, aggregated \$15,454,000,000 or 22.7 per cent above the total of \$12,578,000,000 reported for the previous week, each including but five business days for many of the reporting centers.

Debits for the week under review are \$2,953,000,000 or 23.6 per cent above those for the week ending November 17, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$2,477,000,000, Chicago \$169,000,000, San Francisco \$102,000,000, Philadelphia \$43,000,000, Los Angeles \$38,000,000 and Boston \$21,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$14,657,721,000 as compared with \$11,855,222,000 for the preceding week and \$11,731,850,000 for the week ending November 17, 1926.
