BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 28, 1927, which included but five business days, aggregated \$12,079,000,000, or 25.5 per cent below the total of \$16,224,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review were \$316,000,000 or 2.7 per cent above those for the week ending December 29, 1926, which also included but five business days. New York City reported an increase of \$365,000,000, Chicago \$34,000,000, Detroit \$18,000,000, and Newark \$16,000,000. A decline of \$68,000,000 was reported by Philadelphia, \$17,000,000 by Cleveland, and \$16,000,000 each by Boston and Minneapolis.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,408,173,000, as compared with \$15,358,445,000 for the preceding week and \$11,106,345,000 for the week ending December 29, 1926.
