BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 4, aggregated \$15,550,000, or 22.3 per cent above the total of \$15,550,000,000 reported in the preceding week, and 26.9 per cent above the total for the week ending April 6, 1927.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published since January 1919 amounted to about \$18,195,000,000, as compared with \$17,371,000 for the preceding week and \$14,145,771,000 for the week ending April 6, 1927.
