## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 11, which included but five business days in a number of cities, aggregated \$14,064,000,000 or 26.2 per cent below the total of \$19,064,000,000 reported for the preceding week, and 13 per cent above the total for the week ending April 13, 1927.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$13,276,572,000, as compared with \$198,866,000 for the preceding week and \$12,317,722,000 for the week ending April 13, 1927.
