## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 30, which includes but five business days in most cities, aggregated \$13,327,000,000, or 22.1 per cent below the total of \$17,114,000,000 reported for the preceding week, and 4.3 per cent above the total for the week ending June 1, 1927, which also included only five business days in most cities.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$12,709,000,000, as compared with about \$16,349,000,000 for the preceding week and \$12,098,283,000 for the week ending June 1, 1927.
