BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending January 2, which like the week before included but five business days, aggregated \$20,688,096,000 or 36.5 per cent above the total of \$15,152,277,000 reported for the preceding week, and 12.5 per cent above the total for the week ending January 4, 1928.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$19,641,680,000, as compared with \$14,392,917,000 for the preceding week and \$17,410,980,000, for the week ending January 4, 1928.
