BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 13, which included but five business days for many of the reporting centers, aggregated \$16,856,000,000, or 19.0 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and 31.8 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$16,075,000,000, as compared with \$19,901,000,000 for the preceding week and \$12,017,000,000 for the week ending February 15 of last year.
