BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 10 aggregated \$17,845,000,000, or 12.0 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and 26.5 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year. Both of the last mentioned weeks included but five business days in a number of cities.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$16,934,000,000 as compared with \$19,293,000,000 for the preceding week and \$13,276,000,000 for the week ending April 11 of last year.
