BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 1 aggregated \$18,650,000,000 or 12 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, and 1 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$17,772,000,000 as compared with \$15,816,000,000 for the preceding week and \$18,005,000,000 for the week ending May 2 of last year.
