BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 8 aggregated \$18,301,000,000 or 2 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and 3 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$17,426,000,000 as compared with \$17,772,000,000 for the preceding week and \$16,200,000,000 for the week ending May 9 of last year.
