BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 11, aggregated \$19,550,000,000 or 23 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included but one business day, and 22 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to approximately \$18,544,000,000, as compared with \$15,204,000,000 for the preceding week and \$15,170,000,000 for the week ending September 12 of last year.
