

PRESS STATEMENT.

September 28, 1918.

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's sixth weekly statement of total debits to deposit account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by about 150 of the country's active clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday, September 18 and 25. The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative data by reserve districts for centers reporting both weeks. Further accessions to the list of reporting centers in the outlying and less populous sections of the country include among others the following centers: Grand Forks, N. Dak., Albuquerque, N. Mex., and Tucson, Ariz. It is hoped that the following month will see the consummation of the Board's efforts to have these reports cover practically without exception the more important clearing house centers of the country.
