BANK DEBITS.

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's weekly statement of debits to individual account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by over 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday November 19, and 12, of the present year, and in case of most of the reporting centers also the weekly period ending a year earlier, i. e., Nov. 20, 1918.

A further increase of over 300 millions in aggregate debits to individual account carried the total for the first time beyond the eleven-billion dollar mark, notwithstanding decreases reported for the New York, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh banks. With the exception of these three centers, all the large cities showed increases considerably above the average of 3 per cent. As compared with corresponding 1918 figures, available for 144 cities, debits to individual account showed an increase of about 36 per cent, all the large cities, except Pittsburgh, participating in the increase.

The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for 155 centers reporting complete data for the two most recent weeks, also like figures for the 144 centers for which data are available for the past week and the week ending November 20, of last year.
