BANK DEBITS

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's weekly statement of debits to individual account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by over 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday, March 24 and 17 of the present year and March 26 1919. The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for centers reporting complete data for the three weeks under review.

Debits to individual account reported by 149 of the principal clearing house cities aggregated 9,456 millions, showing a decrease of about 821 millions from the total of the week before. Smaller totals are shown for all the important centers, except New Orleans and Dallas.

For the week ending March 6, 1919, debits to individual account aggregated 6,808 millions or 2,648 millions less than for the corresponding week of the current year. For New York City an increase since last year of 1,488 millions or about 45 per cent is shown, while for the other 148 cities the aggregate increase is about 34 per cent.
