BANK DEBITS

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's weekly statement of debits to individual account reported through the Federal Reserve Banks by over 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday, June 30 and June 23 of the present year and July 2, 1919. The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for cities reporting complete data for the three weeks under review.

Aggregate debits to individual account, reported by 152 Clearing Houses, show a further decline of 201 millions from the total for the immediately preceding week, all the larger centers, except Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Baltimore and Los Angeles, showing reduced totals for the week. As compared with the corresponding period in 1919, viz. the week ending July 2, the most recent weekly total of 4,550 millions for 151 centers other than New York City shows an increase of ~~only 55~~ millions, as compared with an increase of about 850 millions for the week before. It should be remembered, however, that the larger 1919 total includes considerable amounts represented by corporate disbursements on account of dividends and interest and other payments customary at the close of the first half of the year. For New York City the cumulative effect of this factor and of the great reduction in the volume of stock exchange operations is seen in a decrease of 606 millions from the corresponding 1919 total.
