BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts, shows an increase from \$6,465,000,000 for the week ending March 30, to \$7,789,000,000 for the week ending April 6. These debits are reported to the Federal Reserve Banks for banks in 158 of the country's leading clearing house centers. Larger figures for the most recent week are shown for all the leading centers with the exception of Boston and Chicago. As against an average increase for the week of 20 per cent, the increase for New York City amounted to 27 per cent.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week under review were smaller by \$1,225,000,000, or 13 per cent, substantial decreases being shown for all the leading centers. Considerably larger than average reductions are shown for Chicago and Detroit, where the figures for the most recent week are 29 and 28 per cent respectively lower than the corresponding figures a year ago.
