BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve banks by banks in 152 important clearing house centers, shows a decrease from \$8,468,000,000 for the week ending May 18 to \$6,969,000,000 for the week ending May 25, a decrease of about 18 per cent. Reduced totals are shown for all the leading centers, the reduction for New York City alone amounting to over one billion dollars.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending May 25 are smaller by \$2,110,000,000, or about 23 per cent, the lag behind last year's figures being larger for the week under review than for any week since the end of April. Larger than average reductions, as compared with last year, are shown for the debits in Cleveland, New Orleans, Minneapolis and Kansas City.
