BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 153 important clearing house centers, shows but a nominal change from \$6,995,000,000 for the week ending May 25 to \$6,998,000,000 for the week ending June 1. The most recent week had only five business days in most of the districts, as May 30, Decoration Day, is a legal holiday in many states. On the basis of daily averages, debits for the week were 20 per cent above the previous week's average, the increase being due in part to end-of-month payments. Of the leading centers, New York, New Orleans and St. Louis reported larger totals than the week before, while the other centers showed reduced figures.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending June 1 are smaller by \$1,383,000,000, or about 16.5 per cent, to be compared with a lag of 23 per cent shown on the preceding week and of 20 per cent shown two weeks before.
