BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 155 important clearing house centers, declined from \$7,953,000,000 for the week ending June 15 to \$7,889,000,000 for the week ending June 22. While aggregate debits for all reporting centers were thus about \$64,000,000 less than for the preceding week, many of the leading centers, notably Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, and San Francisco, report larger totals for the week under review. Debits for New York City, on the other hand, were smaller by \$104,000,000, a larger reduction than that shown for all reporting centers combined.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending June 22 are smaller by \$1,305,000,000, or about 14 per cent, a smaller lag than that for any week since May 18. With the sole exception of Los Angeles, all the leading centers report smaller aggregate debits for the week than for the corresponding week a year ago.
