BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 147 important clearing house centers, increased from \$6,597,000,000 for the week ending July 27 to \$7,657,000,000 for the week ending August 3, an increase of \$1,060,000,000, or about 16 per cent. All the leading centers, except Cleveland, participated in the increase, which apparently is due in part to the considerable volume of end-of-month settlements.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending August 3 are smaller by \$1,100,000,000, or about 13 per cent, this lag being comparable to one of 18 per cent for the week before. Smaller figures for the week under review, as compared with the corresponding week of 1920, are reported for all the leading centers, except Los Angeles.
