BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 152 important clearing house centers, increased from \$6,744,000,000 for the week ending August 10 to \$6,985,000,000 for the week ending August 17, an increase of \$241,000,000, or about 3.6 per cent. Smaller figures of debits were reported for Boston, New York, Baltimore and New Orleans, the decrease for New York City alone being about \$94,000,000, and that for the other centers combined about \$7,000,000; the aggregate decrease of \$101,000,000 for these four centers compares with an increase of \$342,000,000 reported by other centers.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending August 17 are smaller by \$1,523,000,000, or about 18 per cent, this lag being about equal to the lag reported a week earlier. A comparison with the corresponding week of 1920 shows for all the leading centers substantially smaller figures for the week under review than a year ago.
