## BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 151 important clearing house centers, decreased from \$6,993,000,000 for <sup>the</sup> week ending August 17 to \$6,212,000,000 for the week ending August 24, a decrease of \$781,000,000 or about 11 per cent. Smaller debits were reported for all the leading centers; the decrease for New York alone amounting to \$416,000,000, and for Chicago - \$93,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding week a year ago, debits for the week ending August 24 are smaller by \$1,481,000,000, or about 19 per cent, a decrease comparable to one of about 18 per cent a week earlier. A comparison with the corresponding week of 1920 shows smaller figures for all the leading centers.
