BANK DEBITS

An increase of over \$1,100,000,000 in the volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 151 important clearing house centers, is indicated for the week ending October 5. During that week the total volume of debits was \$8,366,000,000, compared with \$7,262,000,000 for the preceding week, an increase of about 15 per cent, which may be ascribed chiefly to the large volume of end-of-month and end-of-quarter settlements effected during the week. The increase in the volume of business was evenly distributed throughout the country, the totals for all the Federal reserve districts and for all the leading centers being materially larger than the week before.

As compared with the week ending October 6, 1920, total debits for the week under review show a decrease of \$1,629,000,000, or about 16 per cent, compared with a lag of 18 percent for the preceding week. With the exception of Los Angeles, all the leading centers report smaller figures than for the corresponding week in 1920.
