BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 151 important clearing house centers for the week ending November 23, 1921, shows an increase of \$787,000,000, or about 10 per cent, compared with the preceding week's total. Larger figures are reported for all the leading centers, except Boston, Baltimore, New Orleans, St. Louis and Kansas City, the increase for New York City alone, where greater activity on the stock exchange was reported, constituting nearly 90 per cent of the total increase for the week. This increase is due largely to the observance of November 11 as a national holiday, when banks all over the country were closed.

As compared with the week ending November 24, 1920, debits for the week under review are smaller by \$814,000,000, or by about 9 per cent, compared with a much larger lag of about 25 per cent shown for the two preceding weeks. Smaller figures as compared with last year are shown for all the leading centers, except Baltimore and Los Angeles.
