BANK DEBITS

The volume of business for the week ending November 30, which included Thanksgiving day, shows a decline of \$853,000,000, or about 10 per cent, compared with the preceding week. Smaller figures are shown for all the leading centers, with the exception of New Orleans. The statement is based on total debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 154 clearing house centers.

As compared with the week ending December 1, 1920, volume of business for the week under review was smaller by \$860,000,000, or by about 10 per cent, compared with a lag of about 9 per cent shown for the preceding week. Smaller totals this year as compared with last year are shown for all the leading centers, with the exception of Baltimore and Los Angeles. The decline for New York City, however, amounts to only \$83,000,000, or about 2 per cent, while the decline for the other reporting centers was \$777,000,000, or about 19 per cent.
