BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending January 11 shows a decrease of about \$123,000,000 compared with the total for the preceding week, which though containing only five business days, saw a large volume of business due to end-of-year settlements. Smaller figures compared with the week before are shown for all the leading centers, except New York, Detroit, Dallas and San Francisco.

As compared with the week ending January 12, 1921, the volume of business for the report week was larger by \$35,000,000. The total for New York City alone was \$329,000,000 larger than a year ago, while most of the other centers report smaller figures, the most pronounced decreases being shown for Cleveland and for Pittsburgh.
