BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending February 8 shows a decrease as compared with the preceding week of about \$218,000,000, or 2.7 per cent. Most of the leading centers report smaller figures for the more recent week, the decrease for New York City alone being \$235,000,000. On the other hand, larger totals than the week before are shown for Cleveland, Pittsburgh, Minneapolis, Kansas City and Dallas.

As compared with the week ending February 9, 1921 the volume of business for the report week was larger by \$270,000,000, or more than 3 per cent. Larger figures were reported by many of the leading centers, including New York, whose increase constituted about 90 per cent of the total gain for all reporting centers. Among the cities reporting reduced totals this year compared with last was San Francisco for which a reduction of \$30,000,000, or over 17 per cent, is shown.

The number of centers reporting this week is 232.
