BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending March 15 was \$8,283,000,000, showing but a slight increase over the \$8,229,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Most of the leading centers report smaller figures for the most recent week, although moderate increases are shown for Boston, Cleveland, Chicago, Detroit and St. Louis.

As compared with the week ending March 16, 1921, the volume of business for the report week was smaller by \$401,000,000, or by about 5 per cent. The larger figures for the corresponding week in 1921 may be due in part to the fact that it included March 16, and saw a larger volume of income tax checks collected and charged to the tax-payers' accounts than the week of the present year which closed on March 15, the day when the income tax checks were due.

The total number of centers reporting this week is 237, of which 163 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
