BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending November 15 totaled \$9,244,000,000, compared with \$8,204,000,000 shown for the preceding week, which included Election day observed in many cities as a bank holiday. Larger figures are reported for all the leading centers, except Boston, Washington, D. C., Atlanta and Dallas.

For the corresponding week in 1921, bank debits aggregated \$7,694,000,000, the total for the week under review being larger by \$1,550,000,000 or 20 per cent. This year's figures are larger than last year's for all the leading cities, with the exception of Boston and Baltimore. Of the total increase for the year \$946,000,000, or 61 per cent, represents the increase in New York City. The largest relative increase for the year, amounting to about 51 per cent, is shown for New Orleans.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 248 leading centers, of which 164 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
