BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending January 3 totaled \$11,224,000,000, a record figure since the beginning of the service in August, 1918, in spite of the fact that the week included New Year's day universally observed as a legal holiday. The week's debits exceeded those of the preceding week, which was also a five day week, by \$3,676,000,000, or about 49 per cent. The increase in New York City was \$2,323,000,000, or 65 per cent, in Cleveland 90 per cent, in Cincinnati - 72 per cent and in St. Louis - 63 per cent. This large increase in debits is attributable chiefly to the heavy volume of end-of-year settlements.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1922 bank debits for the week under review show an increase of \$2,184,000,000, or 24 per cent. Larger figures are reported for all the leading centers, except Baltimore and San Francisco.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 251 centers, of which 167 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
