BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending July 3 totaled \$10,089,000,000, or 7 per cent more than for the preceding week, though the week contained only five business days, since Wednesday July 4 was universally observed as a holiday and the report week ended on Tuesday, July 3. The larger total reflects end-of-month and end-of-fiscal-year payments made during the week.

As compared with the week ending July 5, 1922, which was also a five-day week, debits for the week under review are considerably larger, increased totals being reported for all the leading centers, except St. Louis, Kansas City, Omaha, and Portland.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 248 centers, of which 243 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
