BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending August 29 aggregated \$7,558,000,000 or about 7.5 per cent less than the total of \$8,168,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Smaller figures are shown for all of the more important centers, except Richmond and Denver which report slight increases. The decrease for New York City was \$233,000,000 or about 6.3 per cent.

As compared with the corresponding period of last year, total debits for the week under review show an increase of \$55,000,000, or less than one per cent. All of the larger centers report increases over last year's figures, except New York, New Orleans and Detroit. The largest relative increases are reported for Pittsburgh, Kansas City and Los Angeles.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 250 centers, of which 244 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve Districts.
