

BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 20, aggregated \$10,463,000,000, or \$1,941,000,000 more than the total of \$8,522,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The large increase is in part due to the fact that the prior week included Lincoln's birthday, which was observed as a holiday in most of the large cities; in part also to the usual mid-month swell of bank debits. New York City reports an increase of \$1,059,000,000; Chicago - an increase of \$158,000,000, Philadelphia - an increase of \$77,000,000, and Cleveland and Los Angeles - increases of \$49,000,000 each.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$344,000,000. The principal increases are reported for Los Angeles, New Orleans, New York, San Francisco, Chicago and Cleveland.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$9,870,500,000 as compared with \$8,011,128,000 for the preceding week and \$9,556,285,000 for the week ending February 21, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 249 centers, of which 243 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve districts.
