BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending August 27, aggregated \$9,046,000,000 or 1.1 per cent below the total of \$9,146,000,000 for the preceding week. New York City reports an increase of \$296,000,000, Detroit - an increase of \$16,000,000, and Baltimore - an increase of \$11,000,000. San Francisco shows a decline of \$63,000,000, Los Angeles - a decline of \$32,000,000; St. Louis - a decline of \$28,000,000, Chicago - a decline of \$25,000,000 and Cleveland - a decline of \$24,000,000.

As compared with the week ending August 29, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,510,000,000 or 20 per cent. Increases are shown for most of the more important centers. New York City reports an increase of \$1,306,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$68,000,000, Boston - an increase of \$62,000,000, and Detroit - an increase of \$40,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,553,734,000 as compared with \$8,598,256,000 for the preceding week and \$7,064,857,000 for the week ending August 29, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 244 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
