BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities aggregated \$10,601,000,000 or 6.2 per cent below the total of \$11,257,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York reports a decrease of \$374,000,000, Philadelphia of \$54,000,000, Chicago \$40,000,000, Detroit of \$39,000,000, and Los Angeles of \$25,000,000. Cleveland reports a gain of \$85,000,000 and Cincinnati of \$14,000,000.

As compared with the week ending January 2, 1924 debits for the week under review show a loss of \$3,000,000, New York City reports an increase of \$324,000,000, and Pittsburgh of \$15,000,000. Chicago shows a decrease of \$47,000,000, Philadelphia of \$32,000,000, St. Louis of \$27,000,000 and New Orleans and Los Angeles of \$23,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$10,085,000,000 as compared with \$10,738,429,000 for the preceding week and \$10,059,307,000 for the week ending January 2, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 242 centers, of which 234 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
