BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities aggregated \$12,209,000,000 or 14.4 per cent above the total of \$10,673,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York reports an increase of \$617,000,000, Boston of \$88,000,000, Chicago of \$76,000,000, St. Louis of \$61,000,000, and New Orleans of \$50,000,000. All the important centers report increases except Cleveland, Minneapolis, and Newark, which show only nominal declines.

As compared with the week ending January 9, 1924, debits for the week under review show a gain of about \$1,700,000,000, New York reporting an increase of \$1,044,000,000, and Chicago of \$130,000,000. Richmond, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Portland, and Seattle are the only important centers showing decreases.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$11,522,000,000 as compared with \$10,084,630,000 for the preceding week and \$9,865,784,000 for the week ending January 9, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 251 centers, of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
